The person who is authorised to certify documents must sight the original and the copy and make sure both documents are identical, then make sure all pages have been certified as true copies by writing or stamping "certified true copy" followed by their signature, printed name, qualification (eg Justice of the Peace, Australia Post employee, etc) and date. The following can certify copies of the originals as true and correct copies: • a permanent employee of Australia Post with 5 or more years of continuous service • a finance company officer (eg: bank employee) with 5 or more years of continuous service (with one or more finance companies) • a Justice of the Peace • a police officer • an officer with, or authorized representative of, a holder of an Australian Financial Services Licence (AFSL), having 5 or more years of continuous service with one or more licensees • a notary public officer • a registrar or deputy registrar of a court.
